ADJOURNED REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS PARTNERSHIP COUNTY OF PLUMAS, STATE OF CALIFORNIA HELD IN QUINCY ON OCTOBER 18, 2023

STANDING ORDERS

Due to the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) Public Health Emergency, dated March 16, 2020, the County of Plumas is making several changes related to Board of Supervisors meetings to protect the public's health and prevent the disease from spreading locally.

Due to Government Code section 54953(e), the Boardroom will be open to the public but subject to state or federal social distancing or masking requirements, if applicable. Chief Allred mentions that the templates presented are from the prior year, and are locked, thus unable to be changed. Mentions that new templates arrive from the BSCC typically on November 1. Sheriff Johns and District Attorney Hollister mention there are no further changes on their end to be made.

County Administrator Debra Lucero asks about whether Opioid funding had been discussed, to which Chief Allred mentions he doesn't think it had. Lucero states there is \$965, 000 available, handled by County Counsel, and that Public Health is working on it. It is open to departments that interact with people who have opioid issues.

Chief Allred mentions Probation and the Alternative Sentencing Program had some revisions in the survey and goals. Looking in particular at the tables with objectives and outcome measures, consideration should be given to providing specific outcomes in next year's plan.
