STANDING ORDERS

Due to the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) Public Health Emergency, dated March 16, 2020, the County of Plumas is making several changes related to the Community Corrections Partnership (CCP) Executive Committee meetings to protect the public's health and prevent the disease from spreading locally.

California Governor Gavin Newsom issued Executive Order N-29-20 on March 17, 2020, relating to the convening of public meetings in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Pursuant to the Executive Order, and the Governor's temporary partial exemptions to the Brown Act, and to maintain the orderly conduct of the meeting, the County of Plumas members of the Executive CCP Committee may attend the meeting via teleconference or phone conference and participate in the meeting to the same extent as if they were physically present. - B. Identify and appoint CCP committee member (non-executive) to following vacant position; discussion and possible action.

a. Vacant position description:

- i. A representative from a community-based organization with experience in successfully providing rehabilitative services to persons who have been convicted of a criminal offense; formerly Scott McCallum

Chief Allred outlines that Scott McCallum formerly held the seat, and that a representative from Plumas County Intervention and Resource Center (PCIRC) had held the seat for many years. The position needs to be filled. Chief Allred states the next candidate would be Cathy Rahmeyer, who is running PCIRC, or potentially other nominations.

Craig Osborne wonders if there is any favor for keeping PCIRC, to which Chief Allred replies they are still heavily involved with related matters in the county. Osborne then asks if there are other programs that are under consideration, to which Chief Allred states that other options had been considered, but with Plumas' size, there is good representation already. A list on the CCP Survey Part A lays out potential candidates, including Plumas Rural Services, School representatives, Behavioral Health, and Head of the County Department of Employment. Chief Allred cannot think of further candidates beyond those but remains open to suggestions.

Sheriff Johns states that although PCIRC has held the position for a long period of time, the position opening could be flown to other agencies, such as the Alternative Sentencing Program (ASP) and others, and then see

what the interest is before simply reinstating PCIRC into the position, to which Chief Allred agrees, and that a public notice will be posted.

Chief Allred states that the new templates had come in, prior work had been transposed onto the new templates, including some minor changes to Probation's section. Chief Allred mentions that while the number of goals in the plan exceeded the template's limits, the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) had provided an additional template with expanded room for goals. The templates are due to the BSCC by December 15th, 2023. Chief Allred is looking for a motion that would grant him permission from the CCP Executive Committee to present Survey A and B and the updated CCP plan to the Plumas County Board of Supervisors, and then finally submit the BOS approved version to the BSCC.
